The Ministry of Foreign Affairs and Diplomatic Mission of Waitaha presents its compliments to the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and Trade of New Zealand and has the honour to convey the decision of the Government of Waitaha to establish a resident diplomatic mission in Pahiatua, Wellington, New Zealand.

The Government of Waitaha expresses its firm desire to strengthen the existing ties of friendship and cooperation between Waitaha and New Zealand. To this end, the Government of Waitaha proposes the establishment of an Embassy, a High Commission, and a Consular Post within the territory of New Zealand.

The Ministry of Foreign Affairs and Diplomatic Mission requests the formal concurrence of the Government of New Zealand regarding the establishment of these missions, in accordance with the Vienna Convention on Diplomatic Relations (1961) and the Vienna Convention on Consular Relations (1963).

Furthermore, the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and Diplomatic Mission wishes to advise that, upon receipt of the formal concurrence of the Government of New Zealand, the Government of Waitaha will proceed with the necessary administrative arrangements to identify and secure appropriate premises for the chancery and consular offices, and will provide the New Zealand Ministry of Foreign Affairs and Trade with the details of the designated Head of Mission and consular representatives in due course.

The Ministry of Foreign Affairs and Diplomatic Mission avails itself of this opportunity to renew to the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and Trade of New Zealand the assurances of its highest consideration.
