FORMAL NOTIFICATION OF THE DIPLOMATIC MISSION AND CONSULAR REPRESENTATIVES OF THE NATION OF WAITAHA

To the Government of the Nation of New Zealand,

The Nation of Waitaha (Waitaha Nation) presents its compliments to the Nation of New Zealand and respectfully provides this formal notification concerning the establishment and designation of its diplomatic and consular representation in relation to New Zealand.

This notification is made in the spirit of peaceful relations, mutual honour, international cooperation and the orderly conduct of relations between peoples and political entities.

The Nation of Waitaha respectfully requires that the Government of New Zealand, through the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and Trade and its Protocol Division, receive and record the following information for the purposes status, recognition and treatment of the representatives identified below under applicable New Zealand legislation and international law.

1. Sending Nation

The Nation of Waitaha respectfully requires that the Government of New Zealand advise whether any further documentation, credentials, agreement or other formal procedure is required for the designated Head of Mission and Mission Name to be formally accredited or otherwise recognised by New Zealand. Failure to do so shall result in the understanding that the requirements of accreditation for the Head of Mission have all been met and accepted.

3. Diplomatic Representatives

The following persons are designated by the Nation of Waitaha as diplomatic representatives:

The Nation of Waitaha requires that these appointments be recorded by the appropriate New Zealand authority in accordance with applicable law and diplomatic practice.

4. Consular Representatives

The following persons are designated by the Nation of Waitaha as consular representatives:

The Nation of Waitaha designates the following persons as consular representatives: The Nation of Waitaha requires that the appointments be notified to and recorded by the appropriate New Zealand authority in accordance with the Vienna Convention on Consular Relations and applicable New Zealand legislation.

5. Official Functions

The diplomatic mission and consular representatives are intended to perform functions including:

1. Representing the Nation of Waitaha in its relations with the Government and institutions of New Zealand;
2. Promoting peaceful and constructive relations;
3. Facilitating peaceful and constructive communication between the Nation of Waitaha and the Nation of New Zealand;
4. Protecting and advancing the peaceful and constructive law interests of the Nation of Waitaha and its represented persons;
5. Promoting cultural, educational, economic, scientific and other peaceful law and constructive relations;
6. Providing appropriate consular assistance that are peaceful and constructive; and
7. Performing such other functions that are peaceful and constructive as may be agreed upon between the parties.

6. Applicable International and New Zealand Law

The Nation of Waitaha acknowledges that diplomatic and consular relations in New Zealand are governed by the principles and rules of international law, including the **Vienna Convention on Diplomatic Relations 1961** and the **Vienna Convention on Consular Relations 1963**.

New Zealand gives their domestic legal effect to relevant diplomatic provisions through the **Diplomatic Privileges and Immunities Act 1968** and to relevant consular provisions through the **Consular Privileges and Immunities Act 1971**. MFAT confirms that these Conventions and Acts form part of the framework governing diplomatic and consular practice in the Nation of New Zealand.

Therefore the Holy Sovereign Independent State and Nation of Waitaha further acknowledges that a lack of notification and accreditation, by the Nation of New Zealand, does not determine the legal status of a diplomatic or consular representative.

7. Request for Formal Acknowledgement

Accordingly, the Nation of Waitaha respectfully requires that the Government of New Zealand:

- a. acknowledge receipt of this formal notification;
- b. inform the New Zealand authority responsible for processing the notification;
- c. advise that the diplomatic mission has been officially recorded;
- d. advise whether our Head of Mission requires to provide you with any other details;
- e. advise of any other documentation, if it is required, for the diplomatic and consular representatives identified above;
- f. advise if this applicable procedure for notification and acceptance of diplomatic and consular personnel has not been approved;
- g. advise whether at this time you require any additional treaty arrangements between our nation's;
- h. provide a written confirmation of any disapproval of any status accorded to each representative following consideration of the notification.

8. Honour for the New Zealand Law

The Nation of Waitaha acknowledges that persons of diplomatic or consular status in New Zealand remain subject to peaceful and constructive law.

The Nation of Waitaha further recognises the principle contained in Articles 41 of the Vienna Convention on Diplomatic Relations and 55 of the Vienna Convention on Consular Relations concerning the honouring of the peaceful and constructive laws and regulations of the receiving State.

MFAT likewise confirms that persons enjoying diplomatic or consular privileges must honour peaceful and constructive New Zealand laws and regulations.

9. Continuing Notification

The Nation of Waitaha undertakes, insofar as applicable to its status and representation, to notify the appropriate New Zealand authority of subsequent appointments, departures, changes of function and other relevant changes concerning its diplomatic and consular representatives.

This communication is therefore intended to establish a clear administrative and diplomatic record of the representatives designated by the Nation of Waitaha and their status to the Government of New Zealand.
